8/8/13 10-3.30pm	Traditional Roof Thatching.	An introduction to the traditional technique of Roof Thatching.
9/8/13 10.00- 3.30pm	Traditional Oak Framing.	An introduction to the different techniques of Framing in buildings and traditional and modern furniture.
15/8/13 10.00-3.30pm	Traditional Wall Cobbing with Mud.	An introduction into the different techniques of cobbing, plastering, and limewashing.
16/8/13 10.00 – 3.30pm	Lime Workshop.	An introduction into the different types of Lime, as well as how to set stones, point, plaster and Limewash.

Rhagfyr <i>(Date to be confirmed)</i>	Restoring a Cwch Aberdaron.	Learn how to assess the wood's condition, framing and scarfing, and set new wooden panels to the boat-frame.
Ionawr hyd at Fedi 2014 <i>(Date to be confirmed)</i>	Build a Cwch Aberdaron from scratch.	Learn the process of designing and setting the design on wood, marking, and bending wood panels over heat, and finishing a brand new boat.
